

Press Release – June 14, 2017

The Mishicot School District Board of Education unanimously approved the hiring of Interim Superintendent Dr. Lee Bush for the 2017-18 school year to replace outgoing Superintendent Dr. Colleen Timm. Dr. Timm has taken a similar position with the Antigo School District.

The Mishicot Board of Education felt that with the timeline of Dr. Timm's resignation and July 1 departure that positioning themselves with an interim superintendent could immediately provide leadership to continue the fine educational programming and assist with the building construction currently going on during the summer. This will also position the Board to set up a timeline for hiring a new Superintendent to lead the District forward for many years during the traditional hiring season and would allow for community input.

Dr. Bush comes with extensive Interim Superintendent experience with prior districts: Stevens Point, Winter, and Brookings-Harbor (Oregon). His career also includes Superintendent, Principal, Assistant Principal, and Teacher positions. Dr. Bush will start July 5th. An announcement of a community meet and greet for Dr. Bush will be forthcoming in the very near future.
